



ENGINEER IN TRAINING, CIVIL

Characteristics of Work

This is entry level engineering work which involves the routine application of federal and statewide programs for the construction and maintenance of structures and facilities such as buildings, dams, water parks, recreational facilities and industrial development projects. The work involves contact with federal, state and municipal officials, consulting engineers, developers and the general public. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate paraprofessional and/or clerical personnel. The work is performed under the direct supervision of an administrative superior or an engineer of a higher classification.

Examples of Work

The following are examples of work performed for positions in this job class, and are not intended to reflect the essential functions of any one position. The essential functions of each individual position are determined and maintained by each individual agency.

Assists or directs in conducting on-site inspections and field tests of structures which are under construction.

Assists or directs in reviewing plans and specifications prepared and submitted by consultants or contractors for the construction of state facilities.

Assists or directs in preparing plans and specifications for new construction and for renovation of existing facilities.

Answers routines questions and provides information about projects under construction.

Related or similar duties are performed as required or assigned.

Minimum Requirements

Possession of a certificate of registration as an Engineer-In-Training from the Mississippi State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers;

OR

A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited four-year college or university in Engineering.

Evaluation Aid: Registration as an Engineer-In-Training with the Professional Board of Engineers and Land Surveyors by the eleventh month of employment is a criteria for conferment of permanent status.

Required Document: Applicant must attach a valid copy of his/her registration as an Engineer-In-Training from the Mississippi State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers.
