



## DOT-MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN II

### **CHARACTERISTICS OF WORK:**

This is skilled work in the operation of a variety of types of heavy construction or material-handling equipment used in construction and maintenance operations. Incumbents in this occupational class are responsible for the safe and efficient operation of equipment used. The work may involve occasional supervision and training of other Maintenance Technicians. Incumbents may be required to perform routine maintenance on equipment operated and engaged in related physical labor as needed. Supervision is exercised over Maintenance Technicians of a lower classification. Supervision is received from Maintenance Technicians of a higher classification or an administrative superior.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

#### **EXPERIENCE/EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

##### **Education:**

Graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED);

**AND**

##### **Experience:**

One (1) year of experience as a DOT-Maintenance Technician I.

**OR**

##### **Education:**

Any combination of education and related experience equivalent to thirteen (13) years.

**AND**

##### **Required Document:**

Possession of a Class A Commercial Driver's License required to be verified by the employing agency..

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK:**

**Examples of work performed in this classification include, but are not limited to, the following:**

Operates front end loader, back hoe, tractor/mower, rollers, compactors. Etc.

Employs all skills necessary for bridge construction or repair.

Operates skid steer loader and other similar equipment.

Operates a fork-lift in loading, unloading, tiering and transferring equipment, merchandise, freight or stock.

Operates single and tandem axle dump trucks.

Employs all skills necessary for sign maintenance.

Removes safety hazards from roadways.

Supervises and participates in the service, upkeep, and repair of equipment operated.

Operates chainsaw and provides other physical labor for tree removal.

Provides physical labor necessary for drainage maintenance.

Performs flagging for traffic control.

Sets up traffic control devices under supervision of another.

Drives and operates large striping machines used in painting center lines and no-pass stripes.

Operates a detail striping machine.

Operates a crack sealing machine.

Operates heavy-duty tractors for hauling large equipment and trailer loads of materials

Serves as a relief operator on motor patrols and bulldozer and other equipment as needed.

Supervises and participates in the service, upkeep, and repair of equipment operated.

Operates a Herbicide truck.

Possesses a Commercial Herbicide Applicator License.

Operates a lift and/or bucket truck.

Performs routine maintenance on equipment/vehicles.

Performs related or similar duties as required or assigned.
